

NOTES

- 1. This record of survey has been filed to show a found monument for the South quarter corner of Section 23, Township 14 South of Range 13 East, Gila and Salt River Base and Meridian, which is significantly different from the South quarter corner shown in Record of Survey, Book 5, Page 60 and Book 7, Page 7
- 2. The following evidence tends to support this corner:
 A. The remains of old fence lines, both North, East & West cross
 - close to the found monument
 - Old and well established trees run North from the corner
 - (Mesquite & Tamarisk)
 - C. Pima County Waste Water Management Plan #G-229, Sheet #7 of 28 dated 1953, shows two corners (12" IP & IP) on this fence line
 - and identify this line as the quarter section line

 D. There are approximately 18 parcels on the North side of 34th

 Street going East from the mid-section line of Section 23, which agree with the line established by this corner and the accepted center quarter corner to the North. The deeds of these parcels date back to at least Oct. 12, 1952. By using the corner accepted by Record of Survey Book 5, Page 60 and Book 7, Page 7 occupation of most of these parcels falls 5 to 8 feet West of the legally described line with the exception of that parcel described in Docket Book 6363, Page 238 which would fall about 16 feet West of the legally described line
 - E. There is a very old axle 1.04 South and 1.12 East of our theoretical Northwest corner of that parcel described in Docket Book 7321, Page 1203
 - F. It is my opion that the 1" steel pin referred to in Records of Survey, Book 5, Page 60 and Book 7, Page 7 would have been lost during the sewer construction and therefore was set about 1953 while the 1" open iron pipe was referenced by the sewer project and is therefore older
- 3. Basis of Bearings: South 00 15' 00" East for West line of Southeast Quarter of Section 23 per Docket Book 656 at Page 207
- 4. It is the belief of this Surveyor that this monument or one in its approximate position was used to establish those lots on the North side of 34th Street and it is important to perpetuate this corner to correctly re-estaslish these parcels
- q- Indicates 2" steel pin set marked L.S. 4680 unless noted
